

## Transport between terminals: Bus Transit (shuttle bus)

### Shuttle bus: T1-T2/T2-T1 Bus Transit

Bus Transit is the free shuttle service that connects the terminals T1 and T2. There are two stops at terminal T1, one on the 3rd floor (P3), Departures area, and at the ground floor (P0) Arrivals area.

This shuttle has increased the frequency of step coinciding with the summer season. The tour lasts about 10 minutes.

Nocturne: 00.00 am to 05.00 am every 20 min  
Early: 5:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. every 7 min  
Daytime: 8:00 a.m. 8:00 p.m. every 4 min  
Rest: 20.00 pm a 00.00 am every 7 min




## Getting to/from the airport

### Train from/to Barcelona Airport

**R2 line** is currently the only line that arrives at the airport from Barcelona (the short name “Barna” is frequently written) or other cities from Catalunya. The train station is in **Terminal 2** (T2).

Travellers from Maçanet-Massanes station have a direct train to the airport, with no transfers. But those passengers from Estación de Francia (Estació de França) can use R2 Sud line (south) trains to go to any of the stations of Passeig de Gràcia, Barcelona Sants or el Prat, and there make a transfer. You have to wait a train with destination “Aeroport” and this train goes to Barcelona Airport.

If travelling from the airport to the city centre you can get off at Barcelona Sants (usually written as Barna Sants), Passeig de Gràcia or Clot which are serviced by metro stops. From these you can change for the Barcelona metro underground system to go to your final destination. To reach Girona (EGPGV’13 venue) you probably want to get off at **Barcelona Sants**.



The train service runs approximately every 30 minutes to and from Barcelona Airport to the city centre. Approximate duration:

To Estació de França	38'
To Passeig de Gràcia	32'
To Barcelona Sants	26'
To Bellvitge	19'
To El Prat de Llobregat	5'

The terminal T2 and the train station (**Rodalies de Catalunya** train station) at the airport are connected by a covered footbridge. This footbridge has a section of elevators and escalators in the nearest favoring the access to people with reduced mobility.



## Reaching Girona from Barcelona Sants

Buy a ticket to Girona from the Barcelona Sants train station (R11 line). There are multiple alternatives, with different timetables. Tickets can be purchased at the station or online in the RENFE's website: <https://venta.renfe.com/vol/index.do>




Figure 1: R11: Barcelona Sants to Portbou per Girona
